USAF Police Alumni Foundation Scholarship Application

The USAF Police Alumni Foundation (USAF PAF) is pleased to present scholarships to assist USAF (AD, AFR & ANG) members and their immediate family members who wish to further their education by pursuing a college degree or training at a vocational/technical school. ONLY the member, spouse, or eligible dependent child (an eligible dependent child is a child who has not yet reached their 25th birthday) are eligible to apply. Family members who live outside the qualifying member's immediate household may not be eligible unless in residence while enrolled in and attending an accredited college or university. Four (4) scholarships in the amount of \$1,000.00 will be awarded each year to selected candidates as follows: two active duty, AFR or ANG and one each to a spouse or dependent child. Applicants must be 17 years of age or older. Qualifying applicants must be currently serving for have served honorably in the USAF as an Air Police, Security Police or Security Forces member. The \$1,000 scholarship shall be used in the academic year following completion of the award. The scholarship may be paid directly to the accredited college/university or vocational/technical school of the awardee's choice, or provided to the awardee to cover academic expenses such as lab fees, books, etc.
